Summer Breakfast and Lunch Program

Once again this summer, the Rowan-Salisbury Schools Food Service will provide a free breakfast and lunch for the children of Brookview, Pine Hill, Linn Lane and East Lafayette. The meals will be served Monday-Friday of each week beginning

Thursday, June 1st. The meals will be served near the community buildings (resourcecenter/scout hut). Breakfast and lunch will be provided at East Lafayette and Pine Hills. Lunch only will be provided at Linn Lane and Brookview locations. An adult resident will be at each site to help the children with their food. All food must be eaten at the site. No breakfasts or lunches are allowed to be taken home. The time of delivery of the lunches to the resource centers has not been determined at the time of the printing of this Newsletter. PATRIOTIC

Pest Control Services

Salisbury Housing Authority reserves the right to provide routine pest control services in your home at no cost to you every 6-8 weeks.

This will serve as an official notice to residents. You will not be required to leave your apartment. While you may or may not have a roach problem in your apartment, even one roach can cause major problems for an entire apartment building. Little or no preparation is needed. All we ask is that you: (1) Have your apartment neat and tidy. (2) Not use any pesticides in your apartment after it has been treated. (3) Allow for access to all areas of the apartment. Make sure no windows or doors are blocked. Roaches do not die immediately, but you will start to see results in 3-5 days. Roach bait will be placed in all apartments owned by this agency unless the current resident provides written documentation from a health care provider which states that roach bait poses a health problem to the resident(s). The bait that is currently being used is odorless and a lot of it cannot be seen. Roach motels are placed out of reach of children in an inconspicuous place, such as cabinets and behind appliances. Please note our policy also states that if more concentrated service is required to eliminate roaches from an apartment which is due to poor housekeeping or other conditions caused by the resident, or refusal of routine service by the resident, the resident will be charged the actual cost of the extended or concentrated service. We want to do everything possible to eliminate all roaches.
