HOW TO AVOID THE FLU...

Parents, please review these tips with your children often to help them avoid the flu!

- Wash hands frequently with warm water and soap;
- Cover nose and mouth with a tissue when coughing and/or sneezing. Throw tissue away and wash hands;
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth to prevent the spreading of germs;
- Avoid close contact with sick people; and
- If sick stay home and limit contact with others.

Symptoms of the common cold include:

- Fever is rare in adults and older children. Small children and infants can have fevers as high as 102° F
- Usually has a runny nose, sneezing, sore throat, and mild cough.

Symptoms of the flu include:

- Fever is usually 102° F, but can go up to 104° F and usually lasts 2 to 4 days.
- Sudden and severe headache.
- Muscle aches are often severe.
- Sometimes experience a runny nose, sneezing, and sore throat.
- Cough is usual and can become severe.
- Tiredness and weakness can last 2 weeks or more.
- Extreme exhaustion.
