Seating is limited.**



**Melt in Your Mouth Chicken Breast**

**Ingredients:**

- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 1/2 cup parmesan cheese, grated
- 1.5 tsp seasoning salt
- 1/2 tsp black pepper
- 1 tsp garlic powder
- 4 boneless chicken breast, halves



**Directions:** Preheat oven 375 degrees. Mix the first five ingredients. Spread the mixture over the chicken breasts and place in baking dish. Bake for 45 minutes.
